- The committee frequently meets with students and faculty members from the SC/ST communities to understand their problems, take required action, and provide them with the necessary advice help to resolve them.
- To encourage greater participation in various activities and to develop responsible and value-oriented leadership in students.
- To have grievance cell to address any issues and complaints for SC/ST students and staffs.
- To promote increased engagement and facilitate the organization of seminars and workshops for students from SC/ST/OBC communities, as well as to cultivate responsible and value-driven leadership among students
