Mentor - Class Teacher Meeting

Corrective measures

- The respective subjective teachers have to identify the weaker students and taken care by the respective subject teachers during the practical hours.

The weaker students shall not be allotted to any mentee.





Mentor – Class Teacher Meeting

- Mentors should make sure that all the mentees have the following:
 - Lesson plan (Theory & Practical)
 - Concise notes based on the question bank prepared by respective subject teachers with the help of the previous year's University question papers.





Mentor – Class Teacher Meeting

- Receive the class test report (CTR) and discussed the possible outcomes with the class teacher.
- The class test status of the weaker students has to be given by the respective subject teachers to the class teacher and the class teacher has to submit a consolidated statement on the status of the weaker students and corrective measurements taken.
- Counseling session has to be conducted and documented.




