

A Report on the Foreign Exchange Program between Krupanidhi Group of Institutions, India and Qiqihar Medical University, China; KGI playing the host.

It was a great pleasure for Krupanidhi Group of Institutions (KGI) to host a 15 days exchange program for students of Qiqihar Medical University (QMU), China, from 24-01-18 to 7-02-18. Eight students from QMU arrived at Kempegowda international airport, Bangalore, at 9.00am on 24-01-18. The KGI team genially received the students at airport and were escorted to the sprawling KGI campus by 11.00 am.


QMU students were welcomed and greeted at the campus with an ethnic dance show followed by gifts and bouquets. Dr. Samuel Paul Isaac, Director, KGI campus welcomed the students and memoirs shared about his visit to Qiqihar Medical University, China and his meeting with Mr. Liu Ji Cheng, President, Qiqihar Medical University. The QMU students gave an introduction and informed that they comprised of 2nd, 4th and 5th year Clinical Medical and public health students. They were given a welcome kit by the program coordinator and teacher, Mrs. Ruchi Agrawal. Students and Dr Paul had lunch together following which, the students dispersed to their rooms at hostel for rest.

The second day began with hoisting of Flag of China followed by the orientation session. The session began with invocation song seeking blessings of God, followed by welcome address by Dr. Sam Paul, Director, KGI. He encouraged the students of QMU to introduce themselves to the dignitaries. This was followed by an inspirational speech by Dr Suresh Nagpal, Chairman KGI, followed by video presentation about KGI and a talk on the inception and growth of KGI by Dr Shyjan, Principal, Krupanidhi Degree College.

The most interesting part of the orientation program was the bilingual talk by Ms. Sonia Ghosh, where she addressed students in Mandarin and shared thoughts on relationship, similarities and differences, between India and China. This was followed by a comprehensive program overview by Mrs. Ruchi Agrawal. She shared the objective of the foreign student exchange program and explained that the program has six modules, namely, language development, personality development & team building, clinical pharmacy, physiotherapy, dance & music and cultural exchange by close interaction and outings with the Indian student buddies. The students and their buddies were given the entire program schedule at the orientation.

The language module had sessions by eminently experienced language trainers of KGI, namely Dr. Shyjan, Ms. Bizu and Mr. Winston. These interactive sessions provided an understanding on the usage of basic conversations in English including common greetings and introduction, phonetics and pronunciations, basic grammar, including parts of speech, use of tenses and interjections, vocabulary and essentials of effective presentation.

Mr. Ajit Kaikini and his team conducted personality development & team building sessions, which were aimed at inculcating and strengthening concepts of focus, belief, team work and effective communication. The sessions were fun-filled, interactive, and students were encouraged to reflect on their experiences and learning after each session.

The clinical pharmacy module was engaged by Mrs. Rajeswari, Dr. Mahesh Nosesnoor and Dr. Trushitkumar Patel, from the College of Pharmacy, KGI. The three sessions of clinical pharmacy module comprised of an overview on the status/availability of medicine information centre at China; Krupanidhi Drug information centre and its functions; discussion about “Web based Drug (Medicine) Information resources” along with hands-on training in strategies for providing drug information services and evidence based practice. The link /sources for free web-based search engines and online subscription web sites were discussed. Another session included discussions on “Medication Chart Review in clinical pharmacy services” where components of patient case sheet were discussed including medication chart. Students were given opportunity to prepare the medicine information using Lexicomp® database, in power point format, with the help of Indian buddies. Students were also briefed about “Importance of Clinical Pharmacy Research in Hospital”. Dr Sandeep from Qiqihar Medical university volunteered a session on “Basics of medical terminology”.

The physiotherapy module was spread over two sessions of 3 hours each. Dr. Sam, Dr. Charu Lata, Principal, College of Physiotherapy, KGI, assisted by their team conducted this session. Dr. Sam gave a brief introduction on physiotherapy and its significance. Dr. Charu explained about the importance of physical therapy along with focus on women’s physiotherapy. A few significant physiotherapy techniques were demonstrated on patients.

In addition to the above sessions, a talk about research at Krupanidhi College of Pharmacy was delivered by Dr. Thomas, Professor, College of Pharmacy, KGI. students were taken for visit to Columbia Asia hospital, Whitefield- which is having collaboration with KGI. Students were given an opportunity to observe a live classroom session in the College of Pharmacy.

Cultural sessions of dance and music were conducted every evening, where the students from China and the Indian buddies learnt English songs and dance steps which they performed together on the Valedictory day.

Over weekends, the students with Indian buddies were taken for Bangalore trip, heritage Mysore tour, and for a shopping experience in the best malls of Bangalore.


On day 14, a valedictory function was organized where students presented the knowledge and skills they had learnt and experienced during the exchange program. KGI awarded the QMU students with the certificates and traditional mementos.

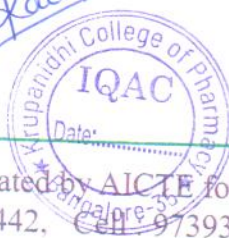
