





INDUCTION TRAINING OF FACULTY REPORT

A 5 days program "Faculty Induction Program" was organized by Krupanidhi Group OfPharmacy during 11.07.2016 to 16.07.2016. The content of the program was prepared according to the different topics related to Higher Education various Resource Persons consisting of Academic Administrators, Academicians from different colleges of Krupanidhi Educational Trust shared rich experiences and insights about being good, effective, motivating teachers who are custodians of values and culture of a society as well as change agents, role model, society and nation building, administrative aspects including procedures and rules.

Day 1:

The session started with the lamp lighting by the senior officials of Krupanidhi Educational Trust.

In the 1st session **Dr Raman Dang**, Principal Krupanidhiollege of Pharmacy delivered a speech on "Integration of Culture, Cognition & Pedagogy" where he emphasized upon different cognitive understanding of human behavior and how it is reflected in one's culture.

Education curriculum and text should have the opportunity to reach every student's individual potential and this should ideally include different ways of knowing, experiencing & understanding life where students can find and value their own voices, histories and culture.


DAY 3:






Day 5:
