QbDCON - NATIONAL CONFERENCE ON RECENT DEVELOPMENTS, PRACTICAL AND REGULATORY ASPECTS OF QUALITY BY DESIGN

QbDCON - National Conference on Recent Developments, Practical and Regulatory Aspects of Quality by Design was organized by Department of Quality Assurance, Krupanidhi College of Pharmacy, Bangalore on Saturday, 11 March 2017 between 9.15 am to 5.10 pm.

QbDCON was sponsored by Rajiv Gandhi University of health Sciences, Karnataka and the event was partnered by Center for Pharmaceutical Professional Advancement, Krupanidhi College of Pharmacy. M/s. Vienni Training & Consulting LLC, Bangalore were the training partners of this event.

A total of 59 delegates from 9 colleges and 2 states registered for the event. The delegates catered to were from faculty, research scholars and also students pursuing M Pharma.
