The anti-ragging committee is reconstituted every year like any other staff association committee as per the college directive. It ensures the implementation of the preventive measure and undertakes frequent and surprise checks/ visits to ensure ragging free campus.

Broadly put ragging is any act resulting in mental/physical and sexual abuse, verbal abuse, and indecent behaviour, criminal intimidation/wrong restraint, under mining human dignity, financial exploitation and use of force. As per the guidelines of UGC and University of Delhi, ragging constitutes one or more of any intention by any student or group of students on:

- Display of noisy, disorderly conduct, teasing, and excitement by rough or rude treatment
- ➤ Handling, including rowdy, undisciplined activities which cause or likely to cause annoyance
- ➤ Undue hardship, physical or psychological harm or raise apprehensive fear in a fresher
- Asking the students to do any act or perform something which any student would not do in the ordinary course and which causes him/her shame or embarrassment or danger to his/her life, etc

**Objectives of Anti Ragging Committee**: The Anti-Ragging Committee will be the supervisory and advisory committee in preserving a culture of Ragging Free Environment in the college Campus. The student volunteers will work under the

- To prevent any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person.
- To prevent any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, posts, public insults
  which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic
  thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or
  any other student.
- To prevent any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.

- 8. Rustication from the institution for period ranging from one to four semesters.
- 9. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period. Provided that where the persons committing or abetting the act of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment. The students of Krupanidhi College of Pharmacy are here by informed that they shall not indulge in "RAGGING". If they are found guilty of ragging they are liable for the above mentioned punishment. The fresher's / junior students are also hereby instructed that they should not respond to the calls from seniors, should not participate in any kind of party anywhere inside/outside the campus, even if ordered by the seniors and that, they have nothing to fear as the institution cares for them and shall not tolerate any atrocities against them. KCP campus is ragging free, still all these measures have been taken to ensure that the fresher's are able to pursue their studies without getting teased, insulted or in any way troubled by the seniors in the name of an obsolete, barbaric ritual. All of this was possible only because of the whole-hearted support from students and teachers.

- 2. Warden and Deputy Warden of hostels should hold PG Degree or Diploma in Psychology.
- 3. Faculty members of the college need to be trained by experts in connection with counselling the students during college hours.
- 4. More number of lady faculty members shall be recruited to guide girl students of the college.
